Project: HelpMeSee Manual Small Incision Cataract Surgery (MSICS) in Chitrakoot, India

**Project Summary:** Restoration of Eye Sight for 100 Adult and 5 Pediatric Patients suffering from cataract

blindness (lens replacement surgeries) in Chitrakoot, India. Our project partner who is located in Chitrakoot, Shri Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya, completed the project in two

weeks' time.

**Project Highlights:** 

Regular screening programs are being conducted in remote villages (where there are no medical facilities) to identify patients with cataract blindness. This is done through schools, village clinics, and communities. Subsequently, the screened patients are transported to the hospital which is about a 1-2 hours drive from the village. The patients selected under the Forix Foundation grant had the necessary pre-surgery examination and were operated. On the second day, after verifying the post-surgery visual outcome the patients were discharged with necessary advice. Attached is the report on the 105 patients. This report is generated from the HelpMeSee Program Quality Assurance System.

1. Suraj: 1 year old boy suffered from Congenital Cataract in the left eye. He is from the village of Dholiya, Hardoi District, Uttar Pradesh State. He was operated on 15 March 2012 and his eye sight was restored.
